



Information technology (IT) managers plan and manage the use of computer systems.

Often the most senior computer person, they will be responsible for every area of the computer systems function.

Usually this involves managing a workforce of computer professionals.

Some of the things a IT Manager might do include:

- work out current and future IT
- develop technological solutions meet company needs
- oversee and manage the installation of IT facilities
- oversee the provision of computer training
- manage how different computer system connect and communicate with one another
- ensure all systems are secure

Other careers you might explore include:

IT Security Manager

Keep all computers secure.

IT Support Manager

Provides assistance support to all users.

Systems Manager

Installs new or modifies existing computer systems.

Knowledge Manager

Ensures all information is managed in the most efficient and reliable way.
