- gather patient history
- examination the patient
- examine X-rays
- adjust the spine or other joints to reduce discomfort
- give advice on general health matters such as exercise and nutrition

- a good level of physical fitness
- able to think and work independently

Education & Training

To become a chiropractor you usually have to study chiropractic science at university. Your year 12 subjects will normally include English and chemistry and/or other science.
